Overview

The Apple Macintosh Quadra 605 personal computer, Apple's most affordable high-performance desktop system, is an ideal multipurpose personal computer for business and professional users. Like all Macintosh Quadra computers, it puts the highest levels of Macintosh performance and flexibility at your fingertips. Yet the Macintosh Quadra 605 brings the cost of high performance down to almost any budget, and its new, slimline design saves desk space.

The Macintosh Quadra 605 uses the powerful 68LC040 processor, so you can scroll, search, and sort through your applications faster than ever before. You'll also appreciate the speed with which the Macintosh Quadra 605 redraws graphics, recalculates spreadsheets, and reformats large documents. It comes with 4MB of RAM on board, expandable to 36MB, so you can work with multiple applications simultaneously.

Like other Macintosh Quadra computers, the Macintosh Quadra 605 includes many standard features that you pay extra for on other computers -- for instance stereo sound and built-in support for all Apple displays (256 colors) and many third-party displays. With additional video RAM, it can display more than 32,000 colors on 14-inch and 16-inch displays.

The Macintosh Quadra 605 also has built-in networking capability, comes standard with an Apple SuperDrive, and accommodates an 80MB or 160MB internal hard disk. Multiple ports provide direct connection to peripherals such as high-capacity CD-ROM drives, scanners, and modems, so you can create the system that fits your needs.

As an added advantage, the Quadra 605 is one of the most energy-efficient systems Apple has ever built, and is fully compliant with the Energy Star program of the Environmental Protection Agency.
