TOPIC -----

This article describes the Macintosh Quadra 610, DOS Compatible computer.

DISCUSSION -----

Two Processors -----Two microprocessors:

- 25-MHz Motorola 68LC040
- 25-MHz Intel 486SX

Because the processors work independently, you can run Macintosh and DOS (or Windows) applications simultaneously -- and copy and paste data between the two environments. MS-DOS version 6.2 is installed on the hard drive, along with the Macintosh operating system (system software version 7.1).

RAM and VRAM

- 8MB of RAM, expandable to 100MB
- 512K of VRAM, expandable to 1MB (Macintosh environment)
- 512K of RAM for video (DOS environment)

Flexible Display Options

You can switch instantly from the Macintosh environment to the DOS environment and vice versa on one display. Or you can add a second display to view both environments simultaneously.

- Features built-in support for one or two displays
- Works with all Apple displays as well as third-party NTSC, PAL, VGA, and SuperVGA displays (Macintosh environment)
- Works with Apple 13-inch, 14-inch, and 16-inch displays as well as third-party VGA and SuperVGA displays (DOS environment)
