Do the Macintosh Centris 660AV, Quadra 660AV and Quadra 840AV use the memory interleaving scheme introduced with the Centris 610, 650 and the Quadra 800?

DISCUSSION -----

No. None of the Macintosh AV Series models use the new highly efficient DMA (direct memory access) based memory architecture. This precludes the need for a memory interleaving design to achieve high performance.
