## Centris 660AV & Quadra 840AV: Speech Recognition Settings (8/93)

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TOPIC
What settings must I check to enable speech recognition on the Macintosh Centris $660 \text{AV}$ and Quadra $840 \text{AV}$ ?
DISCUSSION
For speech recognition to work, the Sound control panel settings must be
• Sample rate: 24.000 kHz (This is the preset rate)
To set the sample rate:  1) Open the Sound control panel  2) Choose Sound Out from the pop-up menu  3) Choose 24.000 kHz from the Rate pop-up menu
• Input Source: Microphone (This is the default setting.)
<ol> <li>Open the Sound control panel.</li> <li>Choose Sound In from the pop-up menu.</li> <li>Click on the Options button.</li> <li>Click the radio button marked Microphone.</li> <li>Click the OK button to return to the Sound control panel.</li> </ol>
• Playthrough: off (This is the default setting.)
<ol> <li>Open the Sound control panel.</li> <li>Choose Sound In from the pop-up menu.</li> <li>Click on the Options button.</li> <li>Make sure the checkbox marked Playthrough is unchecked.</li> <li>Click the OK button to return to the Sound control panel.</li> </ol>
