Can I use the VRAM (two 128K by 8 chips) from a Macintosh LC in a Macintosh Quadra?

DISCUSSION -----

Yes, the VRAM from the Macintosh LC can be used in the Macintosh Quadra. Note, though, if you use the 512K VRAM SIMMs from a Macintosh LC, the Macintosh Quadra sees it as only 256K.
