Where can I get a copy of Cache Switch Control Panel for the Macintosh Quadra?
DISCUSSION
The Cache Switch is designed for any of the 68040 computers. This includes certain models of the Macintosh LC, Centris, Quadra, and Performa computers. It is distributed on the Tidbits disk of System 7 and System 7.1. You can also get the Cache Switch on any of the online services that Apple posts software update on.
The Cache Switch is not installed by the Installer, so you must drag a copy to the System Folder to install it.
