Macintosh Quadras: Applications Incompatible with Internal Cache

TOPIC -----

Every time I try to start up one or more of my applications, my Quadra crashes. The applications work fine on my other Macintosh computers. The problem even happens when I restart with extensions off. What can I do to stop this?

DISCUSSION -----

One or more of your applications may be incompatible with the Quadra's 68040 internal cache. Try using the Cache Switch (found on the System 7.0.1 or 7.1 Tidbits disk) in the control panels, and switch it to "more compatible". Restart and try your application again.

If it works, you may want to see if a Quadra-compatible upgrade of your applications is available from the developer. Also be advised that with the Cache Switch in the "more compatible" mode, you sacrifice some of the Quadra's performance for the sake of the compatibility.
