This article describes the Macintosh TV product. At introduction, Macintosh TV is available in limited distribution and only in the U.S. It is sold through a limited number of consumer electronics and higher-education retailers, and through the Apple Catalog.

DISCUSSION -----

Macintosh TV is a Macintosh computer -- and it's a television receiver and CD player. In one unit, it combines all of these capabilities:

- An affordable Macintosh computer
- Cable-ready 14-inch color TV with remote control
- Video-input port to connect VCR, camcorder, or video game player
- Stereo CD player with remote control
- Stereo speakers

Macintosh TV can be used to view and capture frames from broadcast television and video sources. It can function as a video game platform. It can be used as a CD player with enhanced stereo sound. Interaction with the system is not limited to the keyboard and mouse: Macintosh TV comes equipped with an infrared remote that controls both the TV and CD player.
