Performa 450: Optional Math Co-processor (4/95)

TOPIC -----

Is there an optional FPU (floating-point unit) for the Performa 450 computer?

DISCUSSION -----

The Performa 450 computer can be upgraded with a math co-processor by installing a standard Motorola 68882 chip rated at 25 MHz (or better). The hardware and software will automatically recognize the chip. No further hardware or software changes are required.

A Motorola MC68882 FPU is usable in the Performa 450 though it is no longer available from Apple at the retail level but is available as a service part.
