| TOPIC |
| I want to upgrade the memory of my Performa 405 from four to 10MB. Would I add a card rather than replace the existing one? What is the generic name of the card I should look for? |
| DISCUSSION |
| Memory upgrades for the Performa 405 are accomplished with SIMMs rather than a memory card. |
| To perform a 10 MB upgrade, you need two 4MB SIMMs rated at 80ns or better $(70, \text{ or } 60\text{ns})$. |
| The only cards you'd use with your Performa to improve performance would kan a third-party accelerator card, which could improve the speed of most of your applications, but not increase your memory capacity. |
