TOPIC
This article describes the Macintosh Performa 600's sound capabilities.
DISCUSSION
All sound processing is accomplished by the VASP gate array.
The sound system includes a built-in speaker and an external stereo headphone jack.
CD audio tracks are played in stereo, and computer-generated sounds are played in mono through both channels.
If no headphones are attached, CD audio plays through the internal speake in mono.
System beeps and CD audio are mixed together so both can be heard through either the headphone or internal speaker.
Sound input is accomplished through a stereo mini-phone jack. Copyright 1992, Apple Computer, Inc.
