KanjiTalk on a Performa 600 (3/93)

TOPIC -----

Will KanjiTalk System 7.1 run on a Performa 600? What System Enabler should I use?

DISCUSSION -----

KanjiTalk System 7.1 WASN'T tested with the Performa 600, so the configuration isn't supported. We believe, however, that KanjiTalk System 7.1 should work fine on the Performa 600 since it differs only slightly from the Macintosh IIVx (the Performa 600 doesn't have the 32K processor cache). If you want to try using this configuration, we suggest using the Install Me First disk for the Macintosh IIVi and IIVx (there are localized versions for KanjiTalk) and try the IIVx install first.

By the way, there's a different system enabler for the Performa 600, but it's only required if you're running the 7.1P version of system software. System Enabler 001 (on the Install Me First disk for the Macintosh IIVi and IIVx) should work on the Performa 600, but again, this hasn't been tested.
