

## SCSI Probe: Not Responding After Adding SCSI Drive (6/93)

TOPIC
When I try to run SCSI Probe, I briefly get the wristwatch and the desktop blinks but no SCSI device table comes up. This happened after I added another SCSI hard disk. Before that everything worked fine.
DISCUSSION
You probably have conflicting SCSI device numbers. Check that every SCSI device has a unique number and that none of the external devices have number 0 or 7, which are reserved for the internal hard disk and the Macintosh itself, respectively.
