All new desktop Macintosh computers designed since the fall of 1993 support the PlainTalk microphone.

Macintosh computers that use the PlainTalk microphone include:

- Macintosh Color Classic
- Macintosh LC and Performa 500 series computers
- Quadra 605/LC 475/Performa 475/476
- Quadra 660AV
- Quadra 840AV
- All Power Macintosh computers
- Macintosh 630 family computers
- Power Performa 6100 series computers

The following computers are in the Macintosh 630 family: Performa 630, Performa 635, Performa 636, Performa 637, Performa 638, LC 630, and Quadra 630.

The following computers are in the Macintosh Performa 6100 series: Performa 6110, Performa 6112, Performa 6115, Performa 6117, and Performa 6118.

All other Macintosh computers that support sound input utilize the standard Apple Microphone.
