IDE Hard Drive: Computers and Disk Utilities (2/97)

TOPIC -----

This article lists the Apple computers using an IDE hard disk and describes which hard disk utility program to use.

DISCUSSION -----

The internal hard disk, in some of Apple's computers, is an IDE drive, not a SCSI drive. This could cause compatibility problems for hard disk utility programs.

When formatting the IDE internal hard disk, be sure to use either Internal HD Format or Drive Setup. Drive Setup has replaced Internal HD Format, but you may be able to use Internal HD Format if your computer included it originally. If Internal HD Format does not work, use Drive Setup instead. Drive Setup 1.0.5 is available on online services.

Although the PowerBook 150 also has an IDE drive, you must use Internal HD Format, NOT Drive Setup, with this computer.
