Is there any way to restart a Macintosh II, Macintosh IIX, or Macintosh IIfx server after a power failure?

DISCUSSION -----

There is no software that restarts a Macintosh after a power failure. However, we heard of a new ADB device that restarts a Macintosh after a power failure--just the thing for a remote server or router. It is called JumpStart, from ARCOM.
