Kensington Turbo Mouse and PowerBook Duo Dock (8/93)

TOPIC -----

Are Kensington trackballs compatible with the PowerBook Duo Docks? I am using an old Turbo Mouse, as well as a standard Apple mouse, with my Duo Dock. Sometimes the Turbo Mouse trackball does not work; sometimes the mouse does not work; sometimes neither of them work.

DISCUSSION -----

Kensington trackballs are compatible with the Macintosh PowerBook Duo computers.

The Turbo Mouse ADB 3.0, which was discontinued by Kensington last year, may have problems working with the PowerBook Duo and other new, fast Macintosh models. While most people can use it with the Duo, some have reported freezing and hesitant movement. Because of individual variations from unit to unit, replacing the trackball base ususally solves the problem.

The Kensington Turbo Mouse 4.0 is the currently shipping trackball model. There are no known problems using the Turbo Mouse 4.0 with the PowerBook Duo, Duo Dock, or any other model of Macintosh computer.

Kensington trackballs have a five year warranty. To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, use the vendor name as a search string.
