## At Ease 1.x: Saving Files (8/95)

TOPIC-----

I'm having problems saving my files in At Ease, version 1.x.

DISCUSSION -----

The only known problem with saving files in At Ease, version 1.x, is that some applications will save to folders on floppies while other applications will only save to the root level of the floppy.

Selecting "Save As" under the File menu will force saving to a floppy. Also, making a document a "stationary pad" by checking the appropriate box in the Get Info window will force saving documents to the floppy disk.

Saving to a hard drive can take place when the "Save to floppy" box is checked AND:

- 1) The finder is open in the background.
- 2) A document is already on the hard drive. The document can be opened and saved to the hard drive.
