PROBLEM: When opening MacDraw 1.9 on a Macintosh II or Macintosh SE using

System 4.2, and Finder 6.0, the page comes out grey and the application does not allow any further use of the program.

CAUSE: Either there are no print drivers or the print drivers are damaged.

CURE: If there are no print drivers, install the desired print drivers on

the system. If the print drivers exist but are possibly damaged, discard the current drivers and reinstall the new ones. The old

print drivers MUST be thrown in the TRASH.
