

AELC: Change ClarisWorks Mem Allocation for Grady Profile 11/94

TOPIC -----

When I try to print from Grady Profile I get the message that there is not enough memory to launch the program to print the report. I have 4 megabytes of memory on my Macintosh. What is causing this?

DISCUSSION -----

The Grady Profile application program that comes with the Apple Early Learning Connection (AELC), only checks the preferred memory size of ClarisWorks (the application it uses). On a Macintosh computer with limited memory, this causes the Grady Profile application to display the not enough memory message. To correct this, change the preferred memory of ClarisWorks to 1100 K.
