

## DAL: Common F Messages Coming From VTAM DAL Server to a

TOPIC -----

This article describes the most frequent F Messages coming from a VTAM DAL server to a client.

DISCUSSION -----

VTAM errors are documented in the VTAM Installation Guide and these errors never get sent to the client. There are 'F Messages' which can come from the VTAM server to the client, and the most common are:

F00000001	Terminal I/O Error
F00000004	Invalid or Missing Userid
F00000008	Invalid or Missing Password
F00000012	Password has Expired
F00000016	New Password is Invalid
F00000020	User not defined to Group
F00000024	RACINIT Failed
F00000028	Access has been Revoked
F00000032	RACF not Active
F00000036	Group Access Revoked
F00000100	Userid in Use
F00000108	Server Terminated by Cancel
F00000112	Server terminated by Closedown
