## DAL: SQL/400 Needed for Updating AS/400 Database

TOPIC -----

Concerning DAL for AS/400: will I ever need SQL/400 in addition to the DAL server installed on the target AS/400 to access the database using a DAL application?

DISCUSSION -----

The runtime libraries that come with the OS/400 operating system for an AS/400 give you enough to be able to access data in a read-only manner. The data can have been created in SQL/400, or in flat files (created via DDS or IDDU).

If you wish to do updates, then the SQL/400 licensed product is required. In addition, journaling has to be turned on for the individual dataset within SQL/400.

Unlike all the other DAL Servers, this server can use the feature of SQL/400 that allows access to files that are created via SQL/400 (known as SQL Collections) -- as well as access to flat files created via other methods available on the AS/400, such as DDS or IDDU (files created by these methods are kept in Libraries).
