DAL Server for AS/400: How Much Storage is Needed (3/93)

TOPIC -----

What is the minimum RAM and DASD requirement for the DAL Server for AS/400?
Is SQL/400 a must for it to work?

DISCUSSION -----

RAM is determined by the partition of the Interactive Subsystem of the AS/400, the DAL Server will swap in and out of RAM. The storage requirement on the AS/400 is approximately 3MB of DASD for the DAL Server installation and the demo library.

The SQL/400 licensed product is NOT a must. The run-time portion of SQL/400 that is shipped as part of OS/400 is sufficient for DAL operation. However, if you wish to exercise better maintenance control over database files (update), then we recommended you purchase the IBM-supplied SQL/400 licensed program.

APPC connectivity on the AS/400 side is also required, as the only connection method for this server is a SNA•ps APPC gateway.
