In sorting and finding, HyperCard treats characters with diacriticals the same as other characters.

DISCUSSION -----

For example, the French e with accent is treated as an e without accent, and German vowels with Umlaut are treated the same as vowels without Umlaut. (These characters are not reproduced here because AppleLink is limited to plain ASCII text.)
