What happens when I close a HyperCard script window?

DISCUSSION -----

To close a script window:

- Click the window's close box.
- Choose Close from the Edit menu (or press Command-W).
- Hold down Command-Option and click.

If you close a window in which you've made changes, HyperCard asks you if you want to save the changes before it closes the window.

Shortcuts

To close a script window without saving your changes, press Command-period.

To close a script window and save your changes, press Enter.
