DISCUSSION ------To close a script window: • Click the window's close box. • Choose Close from the Edit menu (or press Command-W). • Hold down Command-Option and click. If you close a window in which you've made changes, HyperCard asks you if you want to save the changes before it closes the window. Shortcuts _____ To close a script window without saving your changes, press Command-period. To close a script window and save your changes, press Enter.
