HyperCard 2.2: Color Tools Troubleshooting (2/94)

TOPIC -----

People with monitors that can't display 16 or more colors can't use the Color Tools stack. On one-bit monitors, the Color Tools stack will show a card that lists its requirements, but it doesn't do this for monitors that are not in B&W mode -- so you may have problems running the stack without realizing why.

DISCUSSION -----

Here are the requirements for using the Color Tools stack:

- At least 2MB of RAM allocated to HyperCard
- 32-Bit QuickDraw (included as part of system software version 7.0 or later)
- A monitor capable of showing 16 or more colors or shades of gray

Also, when using Color Tools 1.0 with HyperCard 2.2, if you:

- 1) Choose Open Color Tools from the Color menu,
- 2) Before the palette is drawn, click on the desktop, and then
- 3) Later go back to HyperCard,

you get Color menus but no palette. The workaround is to close Color Tools and reopen it.
