## HyperCard: Changing the Cursor While in a Field or Button (8/93)

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If this handler is used in a field, make sure the field is locked. If it isn't, and you click the mouse while over the field, any characters typed will be stored in a memory buffer, and the typed text will appear in the field as soon as the cursor is moved away from the field.

Putting this handler at the card level will cause it to change the cursor when it enters any button or locked field on the card. To make the handler respond specifically to buttons or fields only, insert the following line of text between ON MOUSEWITHIN and SET CURSOR TO BUSY:

if "button" is not in the target then exit mouseWithin

Use "field" instead of button if you only want fields responded to with the different cursor.

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
