HyperCard: Converting SuperCard Projects to HyperCard (3/93)

TOPIC
Heizer Software has a utility program, called Homeward, for converting SuperCard projects to HyperCard stacks.
DISCUSSION
Homeward performs about 70% of the conversion work. Projects with multiple windows are no problem. Each window is translated into a new stack, including the scripts and objects associated with each window. Graphics, including color, are converted, as well as first-pass translation of SuperTalk scripts. Color and irregular-shaped objects are handled with XCMDs.
Some work will be required to refine the newly created HyperCard stacks. To aid in this process, Homeward generates a detailed "Exception List," pin-pointing items that may require further attention. Many vendors offer solutions for recreating SuperCard feature which are not directly supported by Homeward, such as list objects and animations.
