TOPIC -----

To specify a sort order in HyperCard, or to treat characters with diacritics differently from those without (in sorting) try:

```
sort [ascending | descending] international by <expr>
```

DISCUSSION -----

An example:

```
sort descending international by field "Hoopla"
```

For programmers only: The sort command follows an order established by the 'itl2' system resource. To customize the sorting order, replace the 'itl2' resource in your system. See Macintosh Technical Note #178, "Modifying the Standard String Comparison".
