Japanese Language Kit: Furigana Support (2/95)

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TOPIC -----

Does the Japanese Language Kit support Furigana (small Kana written next to an unusual Kanji as a guide to its pronunciation), or is that something that would have to be "faked" by adding a very small line above the normal one?

DISCUSSION -----

Furigana is supported by a number of localized products. We know that TurboWriter, EGWord, and Nisus supports Rubi/Furigana, and we believe that MacWrite II-J, WordPerfect-J, PageMaker-J, Quark Express-J, etc., may support this feature too.

We feel that "faking" Furigana by adding an extra line above your line of text is a poor solution because the Furigana needs to be anchored to its associated text.
