## Language Kits: Inline Support (2/95)

TOPIC -----

When inputting Japanese or Chinese text into a Japanese or Chinese TeachText document or into the Finder (including control panels) using the Japanese or Chinese Language Kit the text does not show up inline like in KanjiTalk 7. Why not?

DISCUSSION -----

The inline text feature is not available in the Japanese or Chinese Language Kits because the Text Services Manager Text Edit (TSMTE) patches are not included with the Kits. Thus, inline text support is not available for TeachText, the Finder, or any other application that relies on Text Edit system routine for text input.

However, Japanese or Chinese text can still be input using the standard input window. In addition, applications that implement their own inline code or utilize the Text Services Manager will provide inline support under the Japanese or Chinese Language Kits.
