I'm trying to run Macintosh Basics, and I get a message that I'm out of memory. My Mac seems to have plenty of RAM available. Why won't it work?

DISCUSSION -----

First try increasing the memory allocation in the Get Information box to 2500K - 5500K. If that doesn't work, or if that much RAM isn't available, make sure the Monitors Control Panel is set to 8-bit (256 Colors) or less. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
