Can I run MacX without running A/UX?

DISCUSSION -----

Yes, you can run MacX under Macintosh OS. Basically all Macintosh computers from the Macintosh Plus up to the Quadra 900, and PowerBooks with at least 2MB of RAM and with system software version 6.0.5 or later, support MacX. For color display, at least 4MB is recommended. The Macintosh 512K may run MacX too if you can upgrade with third-party RAM to at least 2MB.
