DISCUSSION -----

MacX is an X Window System display server, developed by Apple for the Macintosh family of computers. The current version of MacX 1.1.7 is X11R4 based.

We assume you're referring to Apple X Window System products that include MacX display server for Macintosh OS and A/UX, and X11 for A/UX (implementations of X Window System, Version 11, Release 4). The X Window System, nicknamed X, was designed by a team of researchers from industry and from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).
