MacX 1.2: File Compatibility with Earlier MacX Versions (4/93)

TOPIC -----

This article describes compatibility with MacX 1.2 of files created in earlier versions of MacX.

DISCUSSION -----

Your MacX 1.1.7 documents are fully compatible with MacX 1.2. If you are in MacX 1.2 and open documents created with earlier versions of MacX, you are presented with an alert box that asks you to preserve or update your default settings. You have two options:

- If you click the Update Defaults button, the default settings of MacX 1.2 are applied to the MacX document that was created with an earlier version of MacX.

The Update Defaults selection provides you with increased compatibility with all X client applications, and you may recognize some improvements in performance.

- If you click the No Change button, the old default settings are carried over to the newly converted document.
