TOPIC
If you're already using MacX 1.1.7, you need to read only the MacX 1.2 Release Notes and the documentation it references. You don't have to reread the MacX 1.1.7 Release Notes unless you want to familiarize yourself with its features.
DISCUSSION
The MacX documentation includes the MacTCP Administrator's Guide, version 1.1, and revised installation procedures for system software version 7.x. These procedures are described in the MacX Installation Guide.
To navigate through the MacX documentation, follow these steps:
• If you're new to MacX, read the MacX 1.1.7 Release Notes first, then read the MacX 1.2 Release Notes. If you're already a user of MacX 1.1.7, you need to read only the MacX 1.2 Release Notes.
• Follow the instructions in the MacX Installation Guide to install the MacX application program.
If you're running MacX on system software version 6.0.x, make sure you read Chapter 3, "Setting Up Communications," in the MacX Installation Guide to learn how to install the Macintosh Communications Toolbox.
• Follow the instructions in the MacTCP Connection Tool Module to install MacTCP and configure the MacTCP driver.
 Read the MacX User's Guide to learn how to use MacX. If necessary, refer back to these release notes for information about MacX 1.2 features not described in the MacX User's Guide. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
