TOPIC -----

Can the AppleShare 3.0 Print Server handle very large (for example, 60MB) print files?

DISCUSSION -----

Theoretically, there are no limits on how large a print file can be -- you are limited only by the available disk space on the server. However, if a client Macintosh has background printing turned on, PrintMonitor may not be able to handle such large files. If that should happen, the workaround is to spool the document to the server with background printing turned off.
