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File Assistant: Turning Off Synchronizer Alert Messages (6/93)

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TOPIC
As you synchronize linked pairs, the PowerBook File Assistant displays messages about the synchronization. These alert messages appear to tell you what's happening, and if files can't be synchronized, they tell you why. If you're synchronizing several pairs of files, you may want to turn off the alert messages so they don't appear on the screen.
DISCUSSION
To turn off alert messages, follow these steps:
1) Choose Preferences from the File menu.
2) Click the Warn When Can't Synchronize check box to deselect it. If you don't want alert messages to appear when a file or folder is put in the trash, you can click the box next to Warn Before Deleting to deselect it.
WARNING: Be very careful if you turn off the alert messages when files are put into the trash. The File Assistant puts a file or folder in the trash during synchronization whenever its corresponding file or folder is deleted or renamed. If you turn these alert messages off, the messages notifying you when a file is put in the trash don't appear.
3) Click OK.
To turn off alert messages temporarily, hold down the Option key. While you hold down the Option key, the alert messages for any commands you execute are turned off. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
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
