File Assistant Synchronizer: Types of Updates (6/93)

TOPIC -----

This article tells you what kinds of updates are possible in two linked items, and what action to expect when you make changes in one of the items.

DISCUSSION -----

There are three kinds of changes you can make to linked items:

- Modify the file or folder.
- Delete the file or folder, or move it to another place on the disk.
- Replace the file with another file of the same name.

When the PowerBook File Assistant notices these changes, it does the following:

- Modify
 - In a two-way link, the unchanged file or folder is updated.
 - In a one-way link, if the arrow points to the unchanged file, the unchanged file is updated. If the arrow points to the changed file, nothing happens.
- Delete
 - In a two-way link, you get a message asking if you want to delete the other item.
 - In a one-way link, if the arrow points to the deleted item, the deleted item is updated. If the arrow points to the undeleted item, you get a message asking if you want it deleted.
