

## Macintosh Pascal: Variable-reference parameter

The variable-reference parameter in a Macintosh Pascal RESET, REWRITE or OPEN command is a reference to the file being accessed. The syntax of these commands is:

RESET(F,P) REWRITE(F,P) OPEN(F,P)

where F is the variable-reference and P is the pathname of the file being accessed. For example, the command Open(TheFile,'Volumel:Inventory') opens the file 'Inventory' on the diskette named 'Volume 1'. That command also sets the variable-reference 'TheFile' so that it refers to that particular file, 'Volumel:Inventory'. Thereafter, commands such as Get(TheFile), Put(Thefile) and Close(TheFile) all access this file, 'Volumel:Inventory'. Apple Technical Communications
