Does MacApp version 3.0 support Pascal?

DISCUSSION -----

MacApp 3.0 supports Object Pascal. However, this is the last release of MacApp that will work with Pascal because of a new Linker being implemented. A new Object Pascal compiler would need to be developed in order to be compatible, and there are no plans to develop such a compiler. Thus, it is strongly recommended that developers convert their code to C++ in order to continue using MacApp.
