Macintosh Educational Software Guide in HyperCard Form

TOPIC -----

Is there a database I can use to search for educational software by on subject, age, and so on?

DISCUSSION -----

The 1992 Macintosh Educational Software Guide is now available as a HyperCard stack on an 800K disk (the Guide is no longer available in printed form). It is an electronic guide to over 1,340 kindergarten through 12th grade educational software products for the Apple Macintosh.

This new format offers some great new capabilities. You can select products by publisher name, grade level, and subject area. The stack can also generate a letter requesting more information from the manufacturer.

Each product listing includes:

- product description
- publisher name, address, and phone number
- education pricing
- grade range
- system software requirements

The files are compressed. When you install the Guide on your hard disk, it becomes a 1.6MB HyperCard stack. The Guide works on all Macintosh computers and requires either HyperCard 2.1 or HyperCard Player 2.1.
