

System 7 Pro: Font Issues with Snapshot Format (12/93)

TOPIC
What's supposed to happen when an AppleMail document is sent to someone in the "snapshot" format, and a font that's used on the sender's computer isn't installed on the client's computer?
Does this affect output possibilities, whether to PostScript or QuickDraw printers and fax machines?
DISCUSSION
An AppleMail snapshot creates a document in PICT format. The PICT format stores the information about the font used originally to create the document. The system that opens the document substitutes the font if the font isn't present. The result is that the recipient's document won't look like the original. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
