

System Software Versions 7.0 and 7.0.1: Removing Fonts (9/94)

TOPIC
This document gives instructions for removing fonts from versions of System 7
earlier than 7.1 for the Macintosh computer. System software version 7.1 stores

DISCUSSION -----

- 1) Close all open software applications except the Finder. If you try to remove fonts when applications are open, a message appears. Click OK.
- 2) Double-click the System Folder to open it.

fonts in the Fonts folder within the System Folder.

3) Double-click the System file. A window appears, displaying individual fonts installed in the system.

Note: To group all fonts together in the list, choose by Kind from the View menu.

- 4) Select the fonts you want to remove, using one of these methods:
 - Selection Rectangle
 - a) Press the mouse button when the pointer is in a blank space in the System window, and continue pressing the button while you move the mouse.
 - b) You'll see a selection rectangle form as you drag the pointer over the names of the fonts you want to select.
 - c) When you release the mouse button, the names of the selected fonts become highlighted.
 - Shift-clicking
 - a) While pressing the Shift key, move the pointer over a font you wish to select, and click the mouse button once.

- b) Continue pressing the Shift key and click on each font you want selected.
- c) Release the Shift key.
- 5) Move the pointer over one of the highlighted fonts, press the mouse button and hold it while you drag the fonts to the Trash.
- 6) Choose Empty Trash from the Special menu.
