I tried to upgrade my Macintosh IIcx to system software version 7.0. During the upgrade, I lost mouse control. I swapped the keyboard and mouse from my Macintosh IIfx, which I successfully upgraded to version 7.0, and tried them with the Macintosh IIcx. I still lost mouse control during the upgrade.

DISCUSSION -----

You may be experiencing an INIT conflict. First, make a backup copy of your System Folder. Then remove the System Folder from your hard drive and try the installation again.

Also, if you are using any third-party ADB devices, contact the manufacturer and ask if there are any known or reported compatibility problems with their product and version 7.0.
