I can't find anything that says it's okay to install new versions of AppleTalk of machines running older systems. Everything I've found vaguel implies that it's okay by saying "Apple recommends using the latest version supplied on Network Software Installer (NSI) version (whatever)".
Are there minimum system requirements for NSI 1.2.3, 1.3, or 1.3.2?
DISCUSSION
Apple currently supports using the N.S.I (all versions of the N.S.I. through 1.3.2.) on Macintosh Operating System versions 6.0.5 and higher. Using N.S.I. to update network components on versions of the operating system previous to 6.0.5 is not supported by Apple. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
