At Ease 1.0: Can't Save Within Folders On Floppy Disk (6/95)

TOPIC -----

I set up At Ease 1.0 to save to a floppy disk. When I try to save a document to a folder on the floppy disk, I get the dialog "Sorry, your work was NOT saved. You can only save onto a floppy disk. Please save again."

DISCUSSION -----

If you have difficulty saving within a folder on a floppy disk, make sure neither of these choices are selected from the At Ease control panel:

- Add a button to At Ease
- Require a floppy disk

Unfortunately, this allows users to save to the hard disk as well as to the floppy disk.

When you select "Add a Button to At Ease" and "Require a Floppy Disk" from the At Ease control panel, some applications allow saving into a folder on a floppy disk and some won't. However, all applications will allow saving to the root level of the floppy disk.
