TOPIC -----

MacCheck just detected a logic board failure on my Macintosh. What should I do?

DISCUSSION -----

If MacCheck detects a logic board failure:

- 1) Shut down your Macintosh by selecting Shut Down from the Finder's Special menu.
 - 2) Hold down the Shift key while restarting your Macintosh. This lets the computer start up without loading any system extensions.
 - 3) Run MacCheck again. If MacCheck still detects a logic board error, contact the Apple Assistance Center or your Authorized Apple Service Provider.
