SPAudit is an application program that inventories all other applications on your hard drive, so that you can verify:
- that you have only one copy of each, and
- that you have legally purchased all applications on your system.
SPAudit is available in both Macintosh and DOS versions. It is included in the SPA self-audit kit, available from Software Publishers Association.
